• Principals Update

- Happy New Year! Teachers and students are happy to be back
- Fully staffed this week; safety protocols were reviewed with parents with regard to cafeteria and recess procedures
- Gaga pit has a loose screw; work order is in for repair
- Kensington Creative Performing Arts High School- working to have an outdoor presentation with subject of Martin Luther King, Jr. once weather gets warmer
- Peace quilt project is an ongoing project
- African American wax museum presentation will be in February; MLK play will be presented by Mrs. Kennedy's class
- Thank you to everyone who gave to the hot cocoa event before the holiday break. It was enjoyed by all and was a special send-off for the staff
- November 10th Minutes will be approved at next meeting
- Treasurer's Report
 - $_{\circ}$ State of Finances
 - Continue to do well this year with fundraising
 - Big events (Fall events)- \$3000 over budget for whole year. Bingo night and family donations still expected this year
 - Expenses are inline with expectations. Most of the expenses expected will be later in the school year
 - o Teacher Initiatives
 - Variety of sensory fidget items for teachers
 - Total cost \$176.92 requested for items

- Occupational Therapist requested equipment to provide teachers with a 'kit' to assist students in classes, if needed. Items are currently shared between multiple teachers/classes
- Vote was held on proposed expense of fidget kits for teachers. Alex Styer Approved; Leesa Dixon Seconded. Vote was unanimously approved by the Committee.
- Ten Adjustable Students Desks were requested
 - Currently have five such desks shared among 25 classrooms to assist students who prefer to stand while working
 - Success of these workstations have created a desire for more teachers to benefit from these desks
 - \$3,609 requested for desk and ball chairs. \$2,100 currently left for teacher initiatives
 - Vote was held to use excess money from fall events will cover expense. If more money is needed to replenish teacher initiatives, a vote can be held at March meeting to move surplus money into teacher initiatives fund. Shannon Elliott made a motion to accept proposal; Jill Kerr seconded. Expense request was approved unanimously by the Committee

Committee Reports

- Fall Book Fair
 - \$3512 was made; surplus of over \$1,000
- Spring Book Fair
 - No chair for the event was found. Given this, online options for the spring book fair are being reviewed
 - Vendors are being reviewed. Many are not as profitable as others
 - Hope to hold event in March
- \circ Globetrotters
 - Link for winter session is up and registration has started
 - Schedule similar to fall; sessions held via Zoom
- o Bingo
 - Committee has been formed
 - April 29th is potential date of event
 - More information will be coming shortly
- Sparrow House Renovation
 - \$15,000 of surplus would be used on project; additional funds could come from H&S or other fund-raising ideas or grants

- Committee has been formed; meeting next week to divide up tasks and get project moving

- Survey will be sent to teachers to solicit their feedback on the project
